

## Outcomes for Pupils

Very positive results with 100% of children achieving expected in reading and writing and 86% in maths and grammar, punctuation (GPS) and spelling. 72% achieved greater depth in reading and writing, 58% in GPS. 14% achieve greater depth in maths but another 42% were within 1 to 3 marks of this grade.

∅ The cohort was small and consisted of only 7 children, five girls and two boys.

∅ Reading – 100% of children achieved expected (national 71%) and 72% were Greater Depth. Average Points across the cohort = 111

∅ Maths – 86% of children achieved expected (national 75%) and 14% were Greater Depth. Average Points = 106

∅ Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – 86% achieved expected levels (national 77%) and 58% GD. Average Points = 110

∅ Writing – 100% expected (national 76%) and 72% GLD.

∅ 42% of children gained scholarships to secondary schools (some being offered up to 3 schools). All children were offered the school of their choice.
