Power Of Reading

The Power of Reading is a whole school development project which supports the introduction of outstanding books together with ways to teach English that are creative, engaging and foster a love of literacy. Teachers attend training sessions to learn about new ideas and teaching approaches and EDS have introduced the scheme in each year group from Reception to Year 6. In KS2 the children are enjoying 'Gregory Cool', 'Charlotte's Web', 'Cosmic' and 'The Last Wild'. They enjoyed designing covers for their class 'readers'.

British Museum



On Tuesday 22nd of February Year Three and Four went to the British Museum. Both classes looked at Ancient Egyptians sections in rooms 61 to 65. We saw lots of images of the Egyptian Gods and Kings of Egypt, also known as Pharaohs. There were lots of pictures of animals; we saw one picture of a farmer ploughing his field for wheat. In room 62 we saw coffins and an elderly woman that wasn't mummified. In her coffin were lots of different objects and artefacts. In the next room we saw a body of a human that was naturally mummified from the temperature in Egypt, it still had teeth and some hair on its head!
